The Village of Long Grove invites you to attend a Second Public Meeting regarding the proposed roadway improvements being planned for N Krueger Road between IL Rte 22 and West Gilmer Road. Improvements will consist of providing a uniform 22-foot wide, two lane pavement section with 3-foot paved shoulders and 1-foot aggregate shoulders throughout the entire corridor. The purpose of the meeting is to present additional information on the plan for the proposed improvements in response to questions raised during the First Public Meeting held on December 15, 2017 and to solicit additional public comments regarding the project.

Most notably, as follow-up to questions raised during the December 15, 2017 Public Meeting the Village performed a comprehensive tree inventory and evaluation on the projects impacts on existing trees. In an effort to preserve as many trees as possible, the Village will be presenting alternative plans that utilize federal funding (incl. 3' wide paved shoulder on both sides of the road) for the improvements North of Eleanora Drive and Village funding for the southern half of the project (maintaining the existing pavement width, no paved shoulders). It should be noted that the Village's improvements stop approximately 500' north of IL Route 22. This Southern 500' feet of N. Krueger Road will be widened to the outside limits of the right of way, requiring the removal of all trees within this section, to accommodate the planned intersection improvements by IDOT

A project overview and comment form are enclosed and are posted on the Village of Long Grove website www.longgrove.net. Additional maps and exhibits will be available for viewing at the Public Meeting.

The second public informational meeting for the planned N. Krueger Road Improvements is scheduled for this Thursday, July 13th. The Village Forester has marked trees along both sides of N. Krueger Road with different color ribbons as follows:

- **RED.** Trees that are scheduled for removal by IDOT as part of their planned intersection improvements. These improvements will require the removal of all trees located within the right of way from IL Route 22 to approximately 300' North of Krueger Court.
- **BLUE (Option A)** – Trees removed under a hybrid funding option with the Village funding the southern portion of the project (300' N. of Krueger Ct. to Eleanor Drive) and federal funding used on the northern portion of the project (Eleanor Drive to Gilmer Road). Village cost \$418,000.
- **YELLOW (Option B)** - Trees removed if the Village used Federal funding for the entire project. Village cost \$380,000.
- **(Option C)** - No trees would be removed if the Village funded the project entirely, not using any federal funds. Village cost \$705,000.
