Benjamin Matthew, 4369 Oak Leaf Ln, wanted to know if there are any updates regarding 4359 IL Route 22 special use application. Village Attorney Filippini answered that he hopes to finish the reviews at the end of the next week. When the application is completed there will be a notice about the public hearing.

Jim Finn described the flooding problem residents experience in their subdivision despite the work it has been done last year. He was asking if there are any plans to install the dam to prevent water flowing to the north side of the street. Village Engineer Perry asked Mr. Finn if he could present any pictures of the problem, but Mr. Finn said that the problem will become apparent during heavy rain event. Mr. Finn requested the resolution that the dam be added this year. Village Engineer Perry said that there was no commitment last year to install the dam and that decision will be discussed with the new Village Manager Sparkman.
